MUTTON BUSTIN' RULES

The Red Lodge Rodeo Association asks that you read the following rules carefully to avoid disappointment as they will be strictly enforced without deviation or hardship exceptions.

- 1. ALL contestants must be between the ages of 4 and 7 years old the day of contestant riding.
- Registration will open one hour (4:45 pm on July 2nd, and July 3rd, and 1:45 pm on July 4th) before each performance and remain open for 30 minutes on the East side of the rodeo grounds just South of the East Concession Stand. Parents for potential contestants must register at this time. Names will not be kept for future performances. Contestants must register each day.
- 3. Contestants must be wearing proper attire to be allowed to register and compete. Proper attire consists of pants, long sleeved shirt, closed toe shoes and protective headgear such as a bicycle or motorcycle helmet. If the proper attire is not present, the contestant will NOT ride.
- 4. One parent or legal guardian will be required to sign a LIABILITY RELEASE and the Acknowledgment of Rules Agreement.
- The drawing will be held at 5:15 pm on July 2nd, 5:15 pm on July 3rd, and 2:15 pm on July 4th. A minimum of nine (9) names will be drawn for the day's performance. Any "contestant/parent" pair not present when the contestant's name is drawn will be disqualified and another name will be drawn immediately. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 6. Mutton Bustin' sponsor *MONIES* will provide a rider for each performance in a manner of their own choosing. *MONIES* will have sole authority to decide how they pick their daily riders.
- 7. Any rider chosen in the drawing to ride in a performance and receive a back number will not be eligible for future drawings in that performance year.
- 8. Mutton Bustin' will follow Intermission. The announcer will call for the day's contestants to report to the RODEO OFFICE with their parent at the end of the CLOWN ACT. The RODEO OFFICE is located under the Bucking Chute seats and is accessible by the door next to the East Concessions. Only one parent will be allowed in the chute area with their child. Any "contestant/parent" pair who does not check in at the end of the CLOWN ACT will be disqualified. Alternates will not be drawn, and the sheep will be turned out. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 9. Scoring is determined by crowd excitement and reaction to the ride. Contestants and parents agree to accept the ruling of the judges without contest.
- 10. **ABSOLUTELY NO RE-RIDES!** Contestants and Parents acknowledge that being drawn as a participant is a privilege and the real prize. They further acknowledge that rodeo is the "Luck of the Draw", and that sheep are unpredictable animals.
